We are looking for highly motivated, competent scientists of Indian Nationality with established credentials and Ph.D. in respective area (Faculty fellow), Ph.D. with at least four years' post doctoral research experience (Assistant professor), Ph.D. with at least eight years' post doctoral research experience including evidence of independent research (Associate Professor) and established scientists with proven credentials for independent research and leadership (Professor). While applications in all areas of research pursued at Bose Institute would be considered, preference would be given to candidates whose expertise and interest would strengthen and/or complement the ongoing programmes. These comprise plan Institutional programmes: (i) Improvement of Plants: Biotechnological, Genomic and Proteomic Approach; ((ii) Protein Structure, Function and Engineering; (iii) Bioinformatics and Computational Biology; (iv) Molecular Medicine; (v) Microbial Genomics and Infection Biology; (vi) Development of Systems Biology and (vii) Basic and Applied Problems in Physical Sciences.
